Colorado Gives Day plans have been finalized at The Rio. Taco Tuesday December the $10^{\rm th}$ 2019. 50% of proceeds donating back to the station.

The Annual Membership Meeting will be held at The Whisk(e)y. 5.30pm Tuesday December the 17th.

New volunteer management system is about to launch. Underwriting software is in house now and Denise will be managing it as our Underwriting Administrative Assistant. We are looking to move staff upward and are working to secure funds to do so.

New pending clients include Budweiser Event's Center, Jeep, Journey Homes, Madwire and the Poudre School District.

We had 40 musicians perform live on air in October.

The Annual Programming Meeting this month was well-attended. The Sunday Programming Schedule has been altered to allow for live drop-ins from local musicians. NoCo Flow now on Sunday afternoons from noon to 4pm will focus on acoustic Colorado music, chill vibes and softer sounds for easy Sunday afternoon listening.

We launched a listener survey and have received over 150 responses so far.

Tim Tilson has been promoted as a volunteer to lead the station's volunteer tech team under Matt Schilz direction.

We discussed board requirements and code of conduct. We are gathering resources and will work to build those.
