2021 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The following is an overview of KRFC's income and expenses for the fiscal year that ended Dec. 31, 2021

KRFC's net income of \$273,495 was largely due to COVID relief funding, increased underwriting revenue, and earnings for KRFC's capital project to build a new radio signal tower. Surplus will be allocated appropriately for the new radio tower and related operational and expenditure increases in FY22.

Additionally, KRFC was fortunate to benefit from significant in-kind resources, including over 9,500 hours in donated time from our dedicated volunteers—valued at \$282,378.

2021 SIGNATURE PROGRAMS

- Live@Lunch: Local and touring bands in the KRFC Ginger & Baker studio for a 1-hour live interview/ performance, broadcast live with technical production and streams worldwide on air and video via Facebook.
- Locally Sourced: Live interviews and acoustic sets from local musicians in KRFC's main studio.
- Rocky Mountain Roots: New in 2021, this 1-hour recorded show features Q&A and newly released music
 with a Colorado Band delving into their story, lives, how they got started, and what inspires them. Also available
 on podcast.
- On-Air Programs: Live programming with Colorado and world music focus, including NoCo Flow (6am-6pm weekdays), World of Symphony Music, Rocky Mountain Breakdown, Poudre Valley Barn Dance, Tejano in the Mixx, Choice City Funk, etc.
- Around Town: Outstanding recordings of performances as they happen in and around Fort Collins for later listening (via a previous Bohemian Foundation grant). This show takes the Northern Colorado scene to a global audience.
- **Community At Work:** This weekly public affairs program offers insights into the issues affecting our community and highlights some of the programs and services provided by local agencies and organizations.
- In The Loop: A short news segment airing seve times per week featuring local news and events in Northern Colorado.
- Community Hub: New in 2021, this dedicated portal on KRFC's website pools resource listings from throughout the community. The Hub also features unique content and programming for areas within the Hub, such as Healthy Aging.
- Concert & Community Calendars: Local community and music events announced on air for a wide variety of
 events throughout the Northern Colorado region, in conjunction with KRFC's comprehensive online concert calendar.
